1. 72-09-ST41. STEP B. Letter of Warning alleging that the Grievant wrote on the mail (defaced the mail) is reduced to a discussion.
2. 72-09-SMS4. Formal A. Letter of Warning alleging unauthorized overtime is rescinded.
3. 72-09-SMS1. Formal A. The 1017-B entry (unauthorized overtime) for 38 units is hereby removed from the Grievant's 1017-B log.
4. 72-09-SMS2. Formal A. The 1017-B entries (unauthorized overtime) for 14 units and 39 units are hereby removed from the Grievant's 1017-B log.
5. 72-09-ST58. Formal A. 14 DAY SUSPENSION alleging poor attendance is reduced to a Letter of Warning.
6. 72-09-ST61. Formal A. TE sent in from another Installation on more than an occasional basis. 5 ODL'S are hereby paid a total of 2.50 hours of penalty pay and 27 units of overtime.
7. 72-09-ST62. Formal A. TE sent in from another Installation on more than an occasional basis. 5 ODL'S are hereby paid a total of 2.00 hours of penalty pay and 4.65 hours of overtime.
8. 72-09-ST60. Formal A. TE sent in from another Installation on more than an occasional basis. 4 ODL'S are hereby paid a total of 2.00 hours of penalty pay and 1.53 hours of overtime.
9. 72-09-SMS3. Formal A. If a Carrier calls back and is told to deliver the mail, the Carrier will not be charged unauthorized overtime for delivering that mail.
10. 72-09-ST44. STEP B. Management will cease and desist failing to process pay adjustments for grievances in a timely manner.
11. 72-09-ST59. Formal A. The Union acknowledges that the TE was sent to Damascus on an occasional basis for this particular case.
12. 72-09-ST63. Informal A. The two 1017-B entries (unauthorized overtime) are hereby removed from the Grievant's 1017-B log.
