- You may also request your PIN from the Postal Service intranet Blue or an employee self-service kiosk click on Employee Self-Service, then PostalEASE, and follow the instructions.
- Or, dial 1-877-477-3273 and press 1.
- When prompted, enter your Employee ID.
- When prompted for your PIN, pause, then press 2.
- Your USPS PIN will be mailed to your address of record the next business day.
