

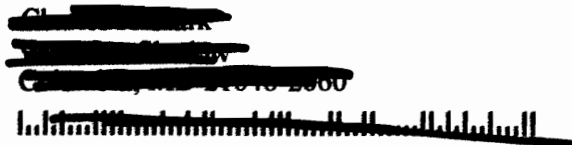
**To get your USPS
Personal Identification Number (PIN):**

- Go to <https://liteblue.usps.gov> and click on "Forget Your PIN?"
- Enter your eight-digit Employee ID (printed at the top of your earnings statement).
- Choose a new PIN immediately with Self-Service PIN Reset—just follow the instructions.
- You may also request your PIN from the Postal Service intranet Blue or an employee self-service kiosk—click on Employee Self-Service, then *PostalEASE*, and follow the instructions.
- Or, dial 1-877-477-3273 and press 1.
- When prompted, enter your Employee ID.
- When prompted for your PIN, pause, then press 2.
- Your USPS PIN will be mailed to your address of record the next business day.

Don't delay—get your USPS PIN today.
