

This was the scribe article from our branch for the May 2012 issue of the Postal Record. We also tried to get this passed at the last National Convention, which failed to pass after lively debate.

The following NALC Branch 3825 resolution, demanding that PMG Patrick Donahoe be fired, was unanimously passed at a recent Union meeting.

Whereas; Postmaster General Patrick Donahoe has announced his plan to reduce the number of USPS employees by 220,000 by 2015 and 120,000 immediately, and

Whereas; PMG Donahoe is fighting to reduce the number of delivery days from six to five which would cost 25,000 City Letter Carrier jobs and 80,000 total Postal jobs, and

Whereas; PMG Donahoe plans to close 3,700 Post Offices nationwide, and

Whereas; PMG Donahoe is lying to the American public about the USPS losing 20 billion dollars over the last 4 years and has created a "manufactured economic crisis", and

Whereas; PMG Donahoe is seeking to dismantle the USPS instead of providing more and better service, and

Whereas; Ruth Goldway, Chairwoman of the Postal Regulatory Commission has repeatedly warned that cutting services is no way for a service business to save itself; on the contrary, it is actually a form of institutional suicide,

Therefore, be it resolved; That NALC Branch 3825 demand that the USPS Board of Governors fire Donahoe and replace him with a PMG who will defend the universal public Postal Service.
